The Ashby School Board is seeking the public's input on future programming and facility needs for the Ashby School District. To gather feedback, three meetings have been scheduled for **March 10th**. The meetings will be held in person in the school cafeteria in a socially distant manner. Masks will be required to be worn. While all three meetings are open to everyone, each meeting will have a directed focus and will last for about one to one & a half hours. The **3:30** meeting will be geared to landowners/farmers, the **5:30** meeting will focus on business owners in the district, and the **7:30** meeting will be directed towards parents/grand-parents.

Administration, school board members, an architect, and a financial consultant will be in attendance to provide a history of this facilities project to date. Further topics covered at these meetings will include enrollment data, curriculum needs, and other school information and updates. Additionally, the architect and financial consultant will answer questions related to the facility assessment, construction costs, and possible tax impacts. However, the most important aspect of these meetings will be the input we as a school board garner from the public we serve. As such, we are encouraging a large turn out for these meetings.
