If technology has been sent home, the student can access materials via Seesaw Teachers will be available for questions via school email between 10:00 am - 3:00 pm Student attendance will be determined based on assignment completion 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will complete their assignments as directed by their teacher. Students will return assignments on the next scheduled school day. If students were unable to complete assignments due to various circumstances, students will be given three days following the snow day to make up the required work. <p><i>*Parents/care providers may reach out to teachers via school email to ask questions or get feedback on assignments</i></p>	<p>Is technology required for our E-Learning days? <i>Teachers will be posting student assignments and expectations using for the E-Learning day on Google Classroom or Seesaw; however, if a student has indicated they do not have access to the internet from their residence, accommodations will be made in order for students to submit the necessary assignments and meet the expectations.</i></p>

Students will know where to locate their assignments on Google Classroom Students will complete assignments posted to Google Classroom or sent home by the suggested due date. Students may connect with teachers via school email or Google Meet to ask questions or get feedback on assignments. 	<p>How will students be expected to “make-up” their learning if not in attendance? <i>They will be responsible for doing the required daily work on their own time as they would in any other situation in which they may have been absent from school.</i></p>
