Preparing Students for Success

Instruction During Quarantine

Expectations for students who are quarantined.

A. Elementary

- a. Students will only be expected to work on core subjects Reading and Math.
- b. Teachers will assign work and share instructional videos through Seesaw.
- c. Teachers will make contact with the families to ensure students are making progress while at home.
- d. Special Education teachers will make contact with students/parents as outlined in the IEP and document contact in SpedForms.

B. Middle School

- a. Students will only be required to work on 4 core subject areas while the three other class expectations and work will be excused. The 4 subject areas students will be expected to work on are: Math, Reading, Science, Social Studies.
- b. Students will find their assignments on Google Classroom along with any instructional videos they may need.
- c. Teachers will reach out at least once during the quarantine period to ensure the student is keeping up with the work and can answer questions if needed.
- d. Special Education teachers will make contact with students as outlined in the IEP and document contact in SpedForms.
- e. Teachers may decide to provide synchronous learning, but it is not required. If this model is used the teacher will communicate with the student/parent the expectations for learning.

C. High School

- a. Students will be required to work on all content areas (7 periods as they are required for graduation credit).
- b. Students will find their assignments on Google Classroom and along with any instructional videos they may need.
- c. Teachers will reach out at least once during the quarantine period to ensure the student is keeping up with the work and can answer questions if needed.
- d. Special Education teachers will make contact with students as outlined in the IEP and document contact in SpedForms.
- e. Teachers may decide to provide synchronous learning, but it is not required. If this model is used the teacher will communicate with the student/parent the expectations for learning.

Should a student's health status change from quarantine to being sick with COVID the instruction will discontinue and expectations will revert to the same as any illness for which a student misses school.
